## **Changing Improper Fractions to Mixed Numbers**

- 1. First, think of the fraction bar as a division symbol.
- 2. Then, divide the numerator by the denominator.
- 3. The whole number becomes the whole number of the mixed number.
- 4. Finally, write the remainder over the original denominator.

  This is the fraction part of the mixed number.

**Example:**

 = 5 ÷ 3 = 1 $\frac{2}{3}$

 $\frac{66}{24} = 2\frac{3}{4}$ 

 $\frac{39}{18} = 2\frac{1}{6}$ 

 $\frac{26}{16} = 1\frac{5}{8}$ 

 $\frac{52}{20} = 2\frac{3}{5}$ 

 $\frac{24}{15} = 1\frac{3}{5}$ 

 $\frac{18}{12} = 1\frac{1}{2}$ 

 $\frac{33}{21} = 1\frac{4}{7}$ 

 $\frac{42}{18} = 2\frac{1}{3}$
