Multiplying Proper Fractions

1. Cancel.

Example: Multiply $\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{10}{16}$

Step 1: $\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{10}{16}$

Step 2: $\frac{1 \cancel{2}}{1 \cancel{5}} \times \frac{\cancel{10}^2 \cancel{1}^1}{\cancel{16}^4}$

Step 2 cont.: $\frac{1 \cdot 1}{1 \cdot 4}$

Step 3: $\frac{1}{4}$

$$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{3} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$\frac{6}{8} \times \frac{6}{8} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$\frac{7}{10} \times \frac{14}{16} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$\frac{8}{10} \times \frac{1}{10} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$\frac{4}{5} \times \frac{1}{12} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$\frac{5}{8} \times \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \times \frac{6}{16} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

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Step 1: $\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{10}{16}$

Step 2: $\frac{1 \cancel{2}}{1 \cancel{5}} \times \frac{\cancel{10}^2}{\cancel{16}_8^4}$

Step 2 cont.: $\frac{1 \cdot 1}{1 \cdot 4}$

Step 3: $\frac{1}{4}$

$$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{3} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$\frac{6}{8} \times \frac{6}{8} = \frac{9}{16}$$

$$\frac{7}{10} \times \frac{14}{16} = \frac{49}{80}$$

$$\frac{8}{10} \times \frac{1}{10} = \frac{2}{25}$$

$$\frac{4}{5} \times \frac{1}{12} = \frac{1}{15}$$

$$\frac{5}{8} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{8}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \times \frac{6}{16} = \frac{9}{32}$$

$$\frac{14}{15} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{7}{15}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{2}{4} = \frac{1}{4}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{12} = \frac{1}{8}$$

$$\frac{4}{10} \times \frac{4}{8} = \frac{1}{5}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{3}{8}$$
